**AMENDEMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN
STEVENS COUNTY AND FERRY COUNTY
FOR PROVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH, CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY,
DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY AND OTHER SERVICES
IN FERRY COUNTY**

This agreement is made and entered into by and between Stevens County and Ferry County.

WHEREAS Stevens and Ferry County entered into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Provision of Mental Health, Chemical Dependency, Developmental Disability, and Other Services in Ferry County on September 1, 2008 which included provisions for amending the Agreement at any time as necessary to address program and service needs within the respective counties,

NOW, THEREFORE, the counties do hereby agree to amend the contract, as follows:

Section A of the Agreement shall be amend as follows:

This agreement shall be effective on January 1, 2016 and shall remain in force, and continue from year to year, until terminated by either party per the termination provisions in the original Agreement.

Section C of the Agreement shall be amend as follows:

The purpose of this agreement is to amend the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Provision of Mental Health, Chemical Dependency, Developmental Disability, and Other Services in Ferry County, and Exhibit 1 of the Agreement, that was executed between Ferry and Stevens County on September 1, 2008. The original terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect except as otherwise amended herein.

Section D (1) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

The services provided in Exhibit-1 by Stevens County shall be financed from revenues received through various contracts with funding entities that include but are not limited to: Spokane County Regional Support Network, Spokane County Behavioral Health Organization (SCBHO), various Health Plans, the Developmental Disabilities Administration, Washington Service Corps, and other contactors.

Section D (2) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

Ferry County shall provide to Stevens County each month, as collected from the Ferry County Treasurer, those revenues received from local tax revenues including: Personal Property Tax, Delinquent Personal Property Tax, Timber Harvest Tax, Leasehold Excise Tax, Liquor Excise Tax, Liquor Profit Tax, for the continued provision of Mental Health, Chemical Dependency, and Developmental Disabilities services exclusively in Ferry County. In addition, Ferry County shall provide to Stevens County dba, "Northeast Washington Alliance Counseling Services" (NEWACS) each month, as received by the Ferry County Treasurer under RCW 82.14.460, funds in the amount as approved annually by the Ferry County Board of Commissioners for the provision of mental health, chemical dependency, drug court coordination, and other related services.

Section D (3) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

Any services revenues collected by the Republic Unit of Northeast Washington Alliance Counseling Services shall be deposited with the Stevens County Treasurer Office as "program revenue" for NEW Alliance Counseling Services.

Section F (1) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

The Interlocal Agreement between the Counties of Adams, Ferry, Grant, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pend Oreille, Stevens, and Spokane for Mental Health Treatment and Services, or any legally executed successor to this Agreement, shall determine the roles of the counties as this pertains to the Governing Board of the Regional Support Network or its successors.

Section F (2) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

Mental Health, Chemical Dependency, and Developmental Disabilities Advisory Boards may be established and maintained for the provision of local input. Advisory Boards may be established by Spokane County Regional Support Network or its successor, and/or by the Board of County Commissioners of their respective counties, either of whom may appoint members to the Advisory Boards.

Section F (4) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

Appointment of Designated Mental Health Professionals (DMHP) in Ferry and Stevens County shall be made by Spokane Regional Support Network or its successor. The NEWACS Executive Director shall recommend to Spokane RSN or its successor duly trained NEWACS clinicians to serve as DMHPS.

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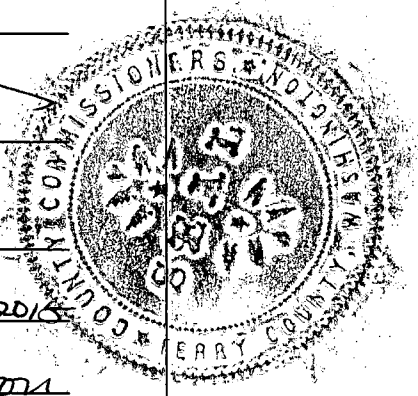


Exhibit-1
