

**AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN
STEVENS COUNTY AND LINCOLN COUNTY
FOR PROVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES
IN LINCOLN COUNTY**

This agreement is made and entered into by and between Stevens County and Lincoln County.

WHEREAS Stevens and Lincoln County entered into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Provision of Mental Health Services in Lincoln County on November 1, 2011 which included provisions for amending the Agreement at any time as necessary to address program and service needs within the respective counties,

NOW, THEREFORE, the counties do hereby agree to amend the contract, as follows:

Section A of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

This agreement shall be effective on October 1, 2018 and shall remain in force, and continue from year to year, until terminated by either party per the termination provisions in the original Agreement.

Section C of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

The purpose of this agreement is to amend the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Provision of Mental Health Services in Lincoln County, and Exhibit 1 of the Agreement, that was executed between Lincoln and Stevens County on November 1, 2011. The original terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect except as otherwise amended herein.

Section D (1) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

Exhibit-1 of the original Agreement is replaced by new Exhibit-1(a). The services provided in Exhibit-1(a) by Stevens County shall be financed from revenues received through various contracts with funding entities that includes but is not limited to: Spokane County Behavioral Health Organization (SCRBHO); Spokane County Regional Behavioral Health Organization Administrative Services Organization (SCRBHO-ASO), Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) including but not limited to Amerigroup, Community Health Plan of Washington, and Molina, the Washington State Developmental Disabilities Administration, the Washington State Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, and other contactors. Any services revenues collected by Stevens County dba "Northeast Washington Alliance Counseling Services" (NEWACS), including revenues for providing services in Lincoln County, shall be deposited with the Stevens County Treasurer Office as "program revenue" for NEWACS.

New Section D (3) shall be added as follows:

Lincoln County shall provide to Stevens County each month, as collected from the Lincoln County Treasurer, those revenues received from local tax revenues as required by RCW 71.20.110 or its successor including Personal Property Tax and Delinquent Personal Property Tax for the continued provision of Developmental Disability and Mental Health services exclusively in Lincoln County.

Section F (1) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

As per the Interlocal Agreement 17BHO 2155 Between the Counties of Adams, Ferry, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pend Oreille, Stevens and Spokane for Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Treatment and Services, for the purposes of governing the SCRBHO, the Spokane Board of County Commissioners will act and function as the SCRBHO Governing Board.

Section F (3) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

Personnel, clinical, financial, and administrative records related to the operations of the Lincoln County Counseling Services Mental Health Program Services prior to September 2003 shall be the property of Lincoln County. Personnel, clinical, financial, and administrative records related to the operations of the Lincoln County Developmental Disabilities Program prior to October 1, 2018 shall be the property of Lincoln County. Each county shall remain responsible for the acts/and or omissions of its employees, officers, and agents regarding Mental Health Program Services prior to September 2003. Each county shall remain responsible for the acts/and or omissions of its employees, officers, and agents regarding Developmental Disability Services prior to October 1, 2018. Each county shall remain responsible for the acts/and or omissions of its employees, officers, and agents regarding Substance Use Disorder Treatment Services.

Section F (4) of the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

Appointments of Designated Crisis Responders (DCRs) in Lincoln and Stevens Counties shall be made by the Spokane County Regional Behavioral Health Organization or its successor. The NEWACS Executive Director shall recommend to the SCRBHO or its success duly trained NEWACS clinicians to serve as DCRs.

New Section G: Manner of Acquiring and Holding Property shall be added as follows

1. Personal Property: For the sum of \$1.00, receipt of which is acknowledged, Lincoln County hereby transfers to Stevens County for use pursuant to this agreement, the personal property listed or described on Exhibit-2, incorporated herein. Upon termination of this agreement, any of these items still in useful service shall be returned to Lincoln County.
2. Real Property and Fixtures: Through the terms of this agreement, and for the sum of \$1.00 receipt of which is acknowledged, Lincoln County hereby transfers to Stevens County for use pursuant to this agreement, the real property and fixtures listed or described on Exhibit-3, incorporated herein. Stevens County shall maintain insurance on said facilities with the same coverage as other facilities owned or operated by Stevens County and shall also be responsible for maintenance and upkeep of said facilities. Stevens County may discontinue use of the real property and fixtures by providing Lincoln County at least thirty (30) business days' written notice. Upon termination of this agreement, Stevens County shall return real property/fixtures as described in Exhibit - 3 to Lincoln County subject to normal wear and tear from usage.
3. Upon termination of this agreement, any real or personal property acquired with funds received for the provision of services to residents of Lincoln County on or after October 1, 2018 shall be returned to Lincoln County.

Exhibit-1 (a)

As of October 1, 2018, Stevens County shall provide Human Services in Lincoln County to the residents of Lincoln County including:

1. Outpatient Mental Health Treatment and Crisis Services as per the Washington Administrative Code 246-341 for which Stevens County dba Northeast Washington Alliance Counseling Services is or shall become licensed/certified;
2. County Day Program Services as per the Program Agreements between the Washington State Developmental Disabilities Administration and Stevens County in effect or that shall become in effect;
3. Vocational and related services as per the Program Agreements between the Washington State Division of Vocational Rehabilitation and Stevens County in effect or that shall become in effect;
4. Outpatient Chemical Dependency Treatment Services as per the Washington Administrative Code 246-341 for which Stevens County dba Northeast Washington Alliance Counseling Services is or shall become licensed/certified to specifically include Medication Assisted Treatment;
 - a. Outpatient Chemical Dependency Treatment Services shall be limited to Medication Assisted Treatment unless otherwise requested in writing by Lincoln County Commissioners after which any outpatient Chemical Dependency Treatment services requested by Lincoln County Commissioners may be provided.
