

BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEVENS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

IN THE MATTER OF CERTAIN CEMETERIES

Ordinance No. 2017-02

PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF LIVING WATERS
MEMORIAL PARK

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable and necessary for communities to have cemeteries adjacent and convenient for the proper care and honoring of their family and loved ones; and

WHEREAS, in the community of Marble, county of Stevens, state of Washington said cemetery exists known as Living Waters Memorial Park jointly owned by Steven and Karen Ramanauskas; and

WHEREAS, said Memorial Park exists and has been properly delineated, recorded and completed all needed registration save the deposit into the Endowment Care Fund; and

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Washington do not require such deposit under RCW 68.40.095; and

WHEREAS, there exists an immediate need for service to be rendered to a beloved founding member of Marble Community; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the county to see to the proper love, honor and respect of its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby established that Stevens County shall exercise the authority given to it under the law and assume the control, maintenance and operation of Living Waters Memorial Park only and until such time as the licensing process is completed by the owners and in any wise not to exceed a period of one year.


FURTHER, it is understood and agreed that this Ordinance in no way implies ownership of the cemetery property but only applies to the mandate of RCW 68.40.095 for the specified time period AND further that the real property lying outside the designated bounds of the existing cemetery, including the house and all structures is in no way a part of this Ordinance and is and will forever continue to be a completely separate property under the complete and absolute care and control of the owners, Steve and Karen Ramanauskas.

FURTHER, it is agreed and understood that the maintenance and operation of Living Waters Memorial Park will be carried out under exclusive contract with the owners of Living Waters, such contract to be not altered or amended except by the express desire of said owners and until this Ordinance is expired and null. At the end of the one year period, at the petition of the owners the county may extend this ordinance for a specified time period and under the same contractual terms hereby attached.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 9th day of June, 2017.


