Ordinance No. 2018-05

CREATING LAKE MANAGEMENT
DISTRICT 1-2018 FOR CONTROL
OF EURASIAN MILFOIL and OTHER
POTENTIAL AQUATIC AND/OR
RIPARIAN NOXIOUS WEEDS at
LOON LAKE

WHEREAS, the Board of Stevens County Commissioners finds that ballots on the issue of whether or not to create a lake management district at Loon Lake for the control of Eurasian milfoil and other potential aquatic and/or riparian noxious weeds were officially tabulated by Stevens County Auditor Tim Gray and the results were presented to the Board on September 25, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that a simple majority vote in favor of creation of the lake management district was received.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Lake Management District 1-2018 is hereby created for control of Eurasian milfoil and other potential aquatic and/or riparian noxious weeds at Loon Lake. The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of adoption of this ordinance as required by law.
