CONTINUING SUSPENSION OF  
ENFORCEMENT OF DOG CONTROL  
MEASURES IN STEVENS COUNTY  
CODE TITLE 20

WHEREAS, the Board finds budget deficits have required that some services be cut back or eliminated pending identification of new funding sources, if any; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds there is not adequate funding for enforcement of Title 20 DOG CONTROL and its enforcement should be suspended again for up to six months to explore alternatives or consider its permanent repeal;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that enforcement of Stevens County Code Title 20 DOG CONTROL is hereby suspended again for up to six months from May 11, 2010.
