ELIMINATING MONDAY PUBLIC
SERVICE AT THE LANDFILL

WHEREAS, the Board finds that increased costs of operation and insufficient revenues require certain solid waste services to be reduced and/or eliminated; and


WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best financial interests of the solid waste disposal system in Stevens County to eliminate Monday public service during the summer months at the landfill which will result in cost savings to all of the patrons of the Stevens County landfill and will help forestall the inevitable increases in tipping fees at the landfill for the present;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Public Works Department Solid Waste Division is authorized and directed to eliminate all Monday public service at the landfill at their earliest possible convenience. All other prior inconsistent resolutions and/or ordinances are hereby amended to reflect this result.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 14th day of June, 2010.
