SETTING A HEARING DATE TO
CONSIDER INCREASING THE
COUNTY ENHANCED 911 EXCISE
TAX TO 70 CENTS PERMONTH

WHEREAS, the Board finds the Governor has signed Chapter 19, Laws of 2010, 1st Special Session, authorizing counties to increase the enhanced 911 excess tax for Enhanced 911 programs to insure adequate funding for emergency communication services ; and


WHEREAS, the Board finds a hearing should be scheduled to receive public comment and input on the new state law and the advisability of raising the county enhance 911 excise tax to 70 cents per month;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that a public hearing shall be held on **Tuesday, September 7, 2010, at 11:30 a.m.** in Room 214, Stevens County Courthouse; 215 South Oak; Colville, Washington, for the purpose of receiving input and recommendations on increasing the E911 excise tax.
