SETTING A HEARING DATE TO
CONSIDER A REQUEST FROM THE
FEDERAL CUSTOMS AND BORDER
PATROL AGENCY TO CONVEY TO
THEM COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY
ADJACENT TO THE NEW
BOUNDARY PORT OF ENTRY

WHEREAS, the Board finds RCW Chapter 39.33 authorizes the county to dispose of surplus property to other governmental agencies on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds the Customs and Border Patrol Agency and Department of Homeland Security have requested that the county convey to them the existing county road right of way adjacent to the new Boundary Port of Entry located in northern Stevens County; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds a hearing is required to be held prior to the decision of whether or not to dispose of the surplus county right-of-way;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that pursuant to RCW 39.33.020, a hearing shall be held at the Stevens County Courthouse; 215 South Oak, Room 214; Colville, Washington on **Tuesday, April 5, 2011 at 11:00 a.m.** to consider the request to convey Stevens County right-of-way adjacent to the federal property located at the new Boundary port of entry. The Clerk of the Board is authorized and directed to advertise and disseminate news releases as provided by law.
