WHEREAS, due to residential development and traffic volumes it is deemed to be in the best interest of public safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Stevens County to establish the maximum rate of speed at which motor vehicles shall be operated on the hereinafter described road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that is shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate a motor vehicle over and along the following described road in Stevens County in excess of the following described speed limit:

Thirty-five (35) miles per hour along State Route Log No. 3625 (Old Inland Empire Highway), known as the Old Arden Highway, from the intersection of it's Northernly junction with SR 395, in the NW1/4 of the NE1/4, Section 4, Township 34 North, Range 39 East, W.M., thence southeasterly 1.47 miles to it's intersection with the Artman Gibson Road, County Road No 38930.

Thence twenty-five (25) miles per hour from said intersction, along said road, heading southwesternly 0.54 miles to it's intersection with the Hall Road, County Road No. 36180.

Thence, thirty-five (35) miles per hour afrom said intersection, along said road, heading southwesternly 1.64 miles to its junction with it's Southernly junction with SR 395 in the NW1/4 NW1/4, Section 23, Township 34 North, Range 39 East, W.M.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2011.
