 } SETTING A HEARING DATE

WHEREAS, ESHB 1886, the Ruckelshaus Process bill, is legislation creating the Voluntary Stewardship Program (VSP) at the Conservation Commission. It is a program intended to protect critical areas on lands where agricultural activities occur while maintaining viable agricultural production; and

WHEREAS, counties must choose to either opt in to the Program or resume the process of updating their critical areas ordinance as it relates to agricultural activities under the existing Growth Management Act processes; and

WHEREAS, workshops/open house meetings are scheduled to provide information to and receive comments from the public; and


WHEREAS, the Board believes it is in the best interest of the county to also hold a public hearing.
