

BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEVENS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Resolution Number 22-2012

In the matter of initiating a county road project designated as CRP NO. 803,

WHEREAS; There is a need to upgrade a portion of the Northport-Flatcreek Road that is gravel to pavement in anticipation of being utilized as a detour route for a Washington State Department of Transportation Project in anticipation of heavy use.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT the Northport-Flatcreek Road, from Milepost 20.12 to Milepost 22.00 be improved as follows:

Existing roadway will receive a BST surface for 1.5 miles in approximately it's current location with the remaining 1/2 mile to be re-aligned and paved to meet current design standards as contained in the "Guidelines For Geometric Design of Very Low Volume Local Roads" as published by the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials and adopted by the Washington State Department of Transportation and ; Be it further resolved that the County Engineer is granted a Design Deviation from the design speed that will prevail for the remainder of the improvement in accordance with the above mentioned standard for degrees of curvature and associated design speed as shown in the project plans prepared by the County Engineer because of topography, natural drainage, property ownership and limited resources;

This project is hereby declared to be a public necessity and the county road engineer is hereby ordered and authorized to report and proceed thereon as by law provided.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an appropriation from the officially adopted road fund budget and based on the county engineer's estimate is hereby made in the amounts and for the purposes shown:

The project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted annual road program in accordance with RCW 36.81.130.
