ACKNOWLEDGING THE SHERIFF'S MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE 911 COMMUNICATIONS CENTER

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Sheriff is also the Director of Emergency Services for Stevens County; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds the Sheriff has examined the duties and responsibilities of both the Sheriff and the Director of Emergency Services and has concluded the management and day to day operation of the 911 Communications Center must be the responsibility of the Sheriff;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board recognizes and acknowledges the Sheriff is responsible for the management and operation of the 911 Communications Center, which shall become a division of the Sheriff's Office. The Board further recognizes the employees of the 911 Communications Center are employees of the Stevens County Sheriff's Office and shall be subject to the authority of the civil service commission except for exempt positions.
