WHEREAS, it appearing to the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, that because of non-use, the following portion of road has ceased to justify its existence as a County Road:

All that portion of J.D. Anderson Rd. #113 (aka Northport-Flat Cr Rd LMO 40050) lying outside of the boundaries of CRP #803. Further described as follows; commencing at MP. 21.38 of the newly constructed CRP #803 thence east for approx ¼ mile to a 90 degree corner; thence north for approx ¼ mile to its intersection with CRP #803 at its MP. 28.85. All located within Section 17/18, Township 39N. Range 39 EWM.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Board that it is its intention to vacate and abandon the above described portion of road, said Vacation to be known as:



DOT/COLUMBIA RIVER BRIDGE DETOUR VACATION OF J.D. ANDERSON RD. # 3435


