WHEREAS, Stevens County is a current member of the Washington State Purchasing Cooperative (SPC) and is eligible order to therefrom, AND

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Office of Procurement called for and awarded a bid for refuse management equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners to purchase a commodity baler in accordance with terms of the aforementioned State of Washington Office of Procurement contract.


