Resolution No. 65-2012

REPEALING RESOLUTIONS 1-2005
and 13-2005 TO ELIMINATE
AUTOMATIC COST OF LIVING
INCREASES

WHEREAS, the Board finds current and past economic conditions have called for smaller budgets, layoffs, furloughs and no cost of living increases for most county employees; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds Resolutions 1-2005 and 13-2005 were adopted to allow cost of living increases for the elected officials of between 2% and 4% per year; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds no automatic cost of living increases should be provided to the elected officials in the future; beginning in 2015 and that the Board of County Commissioners has the discretion to approve increases for elected officials in the future pursuant to the Washington State Constitution Article XXX Section 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Resolutions No. 1-2005 and 13-2005 are repealed effective January 1, 2015.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 3rd day of December, 2012.


