Resolution No. 60-2013

SETTING ASIDE FUNDS TO COMPLY WITH FY 2012 COPS GRANT REQUIREMENTS TO FUND ONE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER POSITION IN 2016

WHEREAS, the Board finds Stevens County, the Town of Marcus and the Town of Northport applied for and received federal funds to provide one law enforcement officer for each entity for years 2013, 2014 and 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds a requirement of the grant approval is that each of the entities independently fund their respective law enforcement position with non-grant funds for the year 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds Stevens County should set aside funds to be able to comply with this grant requirement and pay for the law enforcement position for 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds the estimated amount of funds to be set aside in 2013, 2014 and 2015 is \$57,250 per year for the Stevens County position to be funded for 2016;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that \$57,250 per year for each year 2013, 2014, and 2015 shall be placed in the reserved fund balance of the Current Expense Fund to comply with the federal grant requirements for Sheriff's officers. The reserve amount to be released back into the unreserved fund balance in 2016.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 12th day of November, 2013.
