Resolution No. 64-2013

SETTING A HEARING DATE TO
CONSIDER IMPOSING THE COUNTY
ENHANCED 911 EXCISE TAX UPON
SELLERS OF PREPAID WIRELESS
TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the enactment of House Bill 1971 and its effective changes to RCW 82.14B authorizes counties to make changes to the collection of the enhanced 911 excise tax for the benefit and protection of all users of the enhanced 911 system for emergency communications services in Stevens County; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it has been proposed that consumers of prepaid wireless telecommunications services should share the cost of enhanced 911 emergency communications services within Stevens County with other consumers of communication services as defined and prescribed by the Washington State legislature by passage of House Bill 1971; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds a hearing should be scheduled to receive public comment and input on the new state law and the advisability of imposing the enhanced 911 excise tax upon sellers of prepaid wireless telecommunication services.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that a public hearing shall be held on **Monday, December 23, 2013, at 10:30 a.m.** in the Stevens County Commissioners' Office; 230 E. Birch Avenue; Colville, Washington, for the purpose of receiving input and recommendations on imposing the E911 excise tax upon sellers of prepaid wireless communications services.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 9th day of December, 2013.


