Resolution No. 75-2013

CREATING A VEHICLE
REPLACEMENT FUND

WHEREAS, the Board finds there is a need to set aside funds for the replacement of vehicles for the Sheriff's office, the Juvenile Court, the Assessor and other departments who require vehicles from time to time, outside the Equipment Rental and Revolving Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds there should be created a fund called "Vehicle Replacement" to provide for the orderly monitoring and administration of funding of vehicles and replacement vehicles for departments outside the Public Works Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that a "Vehicle Replacement" fund is authorized to be created and established for the purchase and replacement of vehicles for departments other than the Public Works Department which uses the Equipment Rental and Revolving Fund for such purposes. The Stevens County Auditor is authorized and requested to create this fund and assign an appropriate BARS number to the fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an initial amount of \$200,000 shall be transferred into the Vehicle Replacement Fund from the General Government Department within Current Expense. Additional funds will be considered each budget season or sooner if necessary.


