SETTING A HEARING DATE TO
CONSIDER ALTERNATIVES AND
OPTIONS FOR NOXIOUS WEED
CONTROL AND THE REPEAL OF
RESOLUTION 4-1972 WHICH
ACTIVATED THE STEVENS COUNTY
NOXIOUS WEED CONTROL BOARD

WHEREAS, the Board finds Resolution 4-1972 was adopted on January 17, 1972 activating the Stevens County Noxious Weed Control Board;

WHEREAS, the Board finds the continued taxation of county lands for noxious weed control should be discussed and examined to determine whether or not other alternatives to noxious weed control in the county should be considered and whether or not Resolution 4-1972 should be repealed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that a hearing shall be held on **Monday, April 7, 2014** in the Commissioners' Hearing Room located at 230 East Birch Street; Colville, Washington at 3:00 p.m. The purpose of the hearing is to discuss options and alternatives for noxious weed control in Stevens County and to determine whether or not Resolution 4-1972, which activated the Stevens County Noxious Weed Control Board should be repealed. The Clerk of the Board is authorized and directed to give notice of the hearing as authorized by law.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 20th day of March, 2014.
