SETTING A HEARING DATE TO CONSIDER A
PROPOSED MORATORIUM RESTRICTING THE SITING
and DEVELOPMENT OF MARIJUANA PRODUCTION
FACILITIES, MARIJUANA PROCESSING FACILITIES and
MARIJUANA RETAIL SALES FACILITIES FROM CERTAIN
ZONES WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED
BOUNDARIES OF STEVENS COUNTY AND REPEALING
RESOLUTION #59-2013

WHEREAS, the Board finds that Initiative 502 was passed into law by the voters in the 2012 November general election; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that a moratorium on the production, processing and retail sale of marijuana was adopted on November 5, 2013 in all zones of unincorporated Stevens County pursuant to Resolution #59-2013; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that a proposal to consider imposing a moratorium in limited zones within unincorporated Stevens County should be considered at a public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

1. A hearing on the proposal to adopt an interim moratorium restricting the siting and development of marijuana production facilities, marijuana processing facilities and marijuana retail sales facilities from certain zones within the unincorporated boundaries of Stevens County and repealing Resolution #59-2013 shall be held on **Monday, April 14, 2014 at 3:00 p.m.** in the Commissioners Office; 230 E. Birch Avenue; Colville, Washington.
2. The Clerk of the Board is authorized and directed to give notice of the hearing.
