PROPOSALS FOR PROFESSIONAL  
SERVICES FOR SCUBA SURVEYS and  
CONTROL OF MILFOIL AND OTHER  
POTENTIAL AQUATIC AND/OR  
RIPARIAN NOXIOUS WEEDS AT LOON  
LAKE AND APPOINTING A SELECTION  
COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Loon Lake Management District is in need of professional services for scuba surveys and control of milfoil and other potential aquatic and/or riparian noxious weeds at Loon Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it to be in the best interests of the Lake Management District to hire an experienced professional to apply herbicide and conduct scuba surveys.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to advertise and disseminate the attached Request for Proposals, 2014-2018, PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR SCUBA SURVEYS AND CONTROL OF MILFOIL AND OTHER POTENTIAL AQUATIC AND/OR RIPARIAN NOXIOUS WEEDS AT LOON LAKE. A Selection Committee consisting of members of the Loon Lake Management District Citizen Advisory Committee is hereby appointed to review submitted proposals and make a recommendation to the Board.
