AUTHORIZING A TEMPORARY
LOAN TO THE SHERIFF FOR FUND
#145-999-010 / 911 EMERGENCY
COMMUNICATIONS

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Stevens County Sheriff has received a reimbursement grant for the purchase of new equipment and a stand-by generator for the E911 telephone system; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Sheriff will need a temporary loan to cover the costs of the equipment and generator until the grant funds are received; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds Current Expense monies are available for a temporary loan to the Sheriff until the Sheriff receives the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds no interest should be charged on the loan because the Sheriff is not able to be reimbursed for interest; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds a loan in an amount of up to \$400,000.00 should be made to the Sheriff for up to six months;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Stevens County Treasurer is authorized and requested to make a loan to the Sheriff for Fund #145-999-010 / 911 Emergency Communications from Current Expense in an amount of up to \$400,000.00 for up to six months.
