APPOINTING A PUBLIC RECORDS
OFFICER AND REPEALING
RESOLUTION #80-2005

WHEREAS, the Board finds Second Substitute House Bill 1758, passed by the 2005 state legislature, has added a new section to chapter RCW 42.17 requiring each local agency to appoint and publicly identify a public records officer whose responsibility is to serve as a point of contact for members of the public in requesting disclosure of public records and to oversee the agency's compliance with the public records disclosure requirements of RCW Chapter 42.17; and

WHEREAS, Resolution #80-2005 appointed Lloyd Nickel, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, as the public records officer for Stevens County; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Nickel no longer works for Stevens County;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Resolution #80-2005 is hereby repealed and Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Matt Enzler is hereby appointed as the public records officer for Stevens County. Each county office is requested to post a copy of this resolution in a conspicuous public place to provide notice to the public and, additionally, a copy shall be placed on the county website.


