WHEREAS, funds have been budgeted and are available in the Equipment Rental and Revolving Fund for said purchase, AND

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW Chapter 39.34, Stevens County has entered into an Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with the City of Spokane for the purpose of purchasing goods and services, AND

WHEREAS, the City of Spokane called for and awarded a bid for new dump bodies & hydraulics.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners to purchase two (2) new 10-12 yard dump bodies & hydraulics in accordance with terms of the aforementioned Interlocal Cooperative Agreement.
