

BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEVENS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

IN THE MATTER OF SOLID WASTE

Resolution No. 72-2014

ESTABLISHING OUT-OF-COUNTY
GARBAGE RATE AND TIPPING
FEES FOR TIRES DEPOSITED AT
THE STEVENS COUNTY LANDFILL
AND TRANSFER STATIONS

WHEREAS, Resolution 33-2003 allowed for a surcharge of 25% on solid waste generated by commercial firms, municipalities or franchise haulers outside of Stevens County; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 33-2003 allowed for a cost of \$195 per ton for landfilling commercial loads of tires; and

WHEREAS, commercial loads of tires occupy a disproportionate volume while causing an undue increase in operational costs at the landfill and transfer stations; and

WHEREAS, commercial tire tipping fee receipts were insufficient to meet costs at the tipping fee rate for municipal solid waste.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Resolution 33-2003 is hereby repealed and the out-of-County garbage rate will remain an additional 25% surcharge and the tipping fee per ton for tires in the Stevens County Solid Waste System will increase to \$200 per ton for loads of eight (8) or more tires.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 16th day of December 2014.
