WHEREAS, Williamson Road is a dead end road intersecting with Stephenson Road in southern Stevens County; and

WHEREAS, due to width and geometric limitations combined with potential for traffic conflicts due to increased traffic it is deemed in the interest of public safety and welfare of inhabitants of Stevens County to reduce the maximum rate of speed at which vehicles shall operate on the Williamson Road, more particularly described hereinafter;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, the Board finds and declares it is a public necessity to establish that it is unlawful for any person to drive and operate a motor vehicle over and along the Williamson Road, Co. Rd. Number 17540 in Stevens County in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that proper signs denoting said reduced speed limit be erected on the above Stevens County Roadways where deemed necessary.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 27th day of January, 2015.


