APPOINTING A PUBLIC RECORDS  
OFFICER AND REPEALING  
RESOLUTION #35-2014

WHEREAS, the Board finds RCW 42.56.580 requires each local agency to appoint and publicly identify a public records officer whose responsibility is to serve as a point of contact for members of the public in requesting disclosure of public records and to oversee the agency's compliance with the public records disclosure requirements of RCW Chapter 42.56.580; and

WHEREAS, Resolution #35-2014 appointed Matt Enzler, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, as the public records officer for Stevens County; and


WHEREAS, Prosecuting Attorney Tim Rasmussen would like Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Nick Force to assume those responsibilities.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Resolution #35-2014 is hereby repealed and **Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Nick Force is hereby appointed as the public records officer for Stevens County**. Each county office is requested to post a copy of this resolution in a conspicuous public place to provide notice to the public and, additionally, a copy shall be placed on the county website.
