WHEREAS, it appearing to the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, that because of non-use, the following portion of road has ceased to justify its existence as a County Road:

A portion of the Change in May Rd #1016 (aka May Road LMO #45850); said vacation commencing at a point approximately 1.9 miles north of said roads intersection with 5th and Main Streets in Colville and continuing in a northeasterly direction for approximately .50 mile; all within Section 32, Township 36 North, Range 39 East, W.M.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Board that it is its intention to vacate and abandon the above described portion of road, said vacation to be known as:


VACATION # 2 OF CHANGE IN MAY ROAD #3449




