IN THE MATTER of Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, declaring the intention to vacate and abandon the following described portion of County Road:

A 16 foot wide strip of property located in the Plat of Loon Lake Park, between lots 11-14 of Block 1, not to include property by block 14 and lots 8-10 of Block 1, in Section 33, Township 30 North, Range 41 East, W.M. Said strip of land more particularly described and shown on Map of Loon Lake Park, Book A, Page 43. Parcel number exempt.


This matter coming on regularly for hearing on the 17th day of March, 2015, at 10:45 a.m. it appearing that notice of said hearing has been given for the time and in the manner provided by law, it further appearing that the portion of road described herein is no longer necessary as a public road; that the vacation will be a benefit to Stevens County, and there being no reasonable evidence presented in opposition to the vacation and abandonment thereof, and the Board being fully advised in the premises.


