

BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEVENS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

IN THE MATTER OF A ONE-TIME SOLID WASTE TIPPING FEE REDUCTION TO ASSIST EPA ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP ACTIVITIES IN NORTHPORT

Resolution No. 65-2015

DECREASING THE TIPPING FEE FOR CONTAMINATED SOIL FROM THE NORTPORT EPA CLEANUP BY TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT TO BE DEPOSITED AT THE STEVENS COUNTY LANDFILL

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the cleanup process requires loads of contaminated soil to be watered for safe transport to the Stevens County Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that disposition of said soil has been approved by Northeast Tri County Health District as intermediate cover at the Stevens County Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that as a result of the transporting procedures a higher than normal moisture content is possessed by the soil; and,

WHEREAS, the majority of water (up to 25 percent) contained within the soils is expected to evaporate as a result of normal landfill operations; and,

WHEREAS, this soil will be of a beneficial use to the Stevens County Landfill.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the tipping fee at the Stevens County Landfill be reduced by 25 percent for this EPA project and shall constitute a one-time, project specific tipping fee reduction only.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 8th day of September, 2015.
