INITIATING COUNTY ROAD

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, that the Lotze Creek Road/Safety Improvement Project be established as a project for constructing 0.3 miles of said road from M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 0.30; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Lotze Creek Road/Safety Improvement Project be designated as CRP-811.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this project is hereby declared to be a public necessity and the County Road Engineer is hereby ordered and authorized to report and proceed thereon as by law provided in R.C.W. 36.75 and R.C.W. 36.80.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an appropriation from the officially adopted road fund budget and based on the County Engineer's estimate is hereby made in the amounts and for the purposes shown:

Right of Way Acquisition	<u>\$ 0.00</u>
Construction	<u>\$ 125,000.00</u>
Total	<u>\$ 150,000.00</u>

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted annual road program in accordance with RCW 36.81.130 and that construction is to be accomplished by contract in accordance with RCW 36.77.020 et. seq.


