Resolution No. 74-2015

REPEALING RESOLUTION #37-2002
AND RESOLUTION #100-1994
RELATING TO NOXIOUS WEED
ASSESSMENTS

WHEREAS, the Board finds that on September 22, 2015, the Stevens County Commissioners approved Resolution #70-2015, which repealed Resolution #65-2008, established the categories / classifications of parcels relating to noxious weed control, set assessment rates and exempted certain parcels from assessment; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that two earlier resolutions should have also been repealed at that time.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that **Resolution #37-2002 and Resolution #100-1994 are hereby repealed** in their entirety and that Resolution #70-2015 remains in effect regarding categories / classifications of parcels, assessment rates and exempted parcels relating to noxious weed control.






