IN THE MATTER OF THE 2016 BUDGET

Resolution No. 1-2016

REPEALING RESOLUTION #84-2015 AND  
RECOGNIZING SUBSTANTIAL NEED

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of both the Current Expense and Road Taxing Districts has determined that due to economic hardship and substantial need, there is a need to increase the regular property tax limit factor above the rate of inflation and current IPD of 0.251 percent; and

WHEREAS, the Stevens County Commissioners passed Resolution #84-2015, which did not clearly reflect their intent to increase the limit factor by one percent (1%) above the previous collection.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners for both the Current Expense and Road Taxing Districts that Resolution #84-2015 is hereby repealed and the limit factor for the tax year 2015 to be collected in 2016 **shall be one hundred one percent (101%)**.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2016.


