SETTING OFFICE HOURS FOR VARIOUS
COUNTY OFFICES AND REPEALING
PREVIOUS RESOLUTIONS

WHEREAS, the Board finds RCW 36.16.100 provides that the legislative authority shall prescribe the days and hours that county offices shall be open for the transaction of business; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that many offices have had varying office hours to accommodate 37.5 hour work weeks and reduced staff; and

WHEREAS, most employees have been returned to 40-hour work weeks.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners that, effective January 1, 2016, the offices of Assessor, Auditor, Treasurer, Sheriff, Prosecutor, District Court, Superior Court Clerk, Juvenile, Commissioners, Land Services and Information Services shall be open to the public for the transaction of business during the hours of **8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that previous resolutions setting office hours for these offices/departments are hereby repealed, including Resolution #9-2003.
