ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO STEVENS COUNTY FIRE
DISTRICT NO. 13

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Stevens County Fire District No. 13 submitted Resolution No. 01-2016 and amended Resolution No. 05-2016 to the Stevens County Auditor requesting annexation of certain territory; AND

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 52.04.011(1), the Stevens County Auditor has determined that the petition was signed by 90.91% of the area voters which exceeds the minimum requirement of 15% and the 60% majority needed to avoid placing this annexation on the ballot and allows the Board to forgo the public hearing and accept and approve the annexation under the election method; AND

WHEREAS, the Auditor has verified that the area requested to be annexed meets the necessary requirement for annexation; AND

WHEREAS, the Auditor presented these details to the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, on May 16, 2016 and with corrected legal description on May 31, 2016; AND

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the requirements of RCW 52.04.011 have been met and the Commissioners of Stevens County Fire District No. 13 concur in the annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners that pursuant to RCW 52.04.011:


1. An election in the territory and a hearing on the petition shall be dispensed with; AND
2. The following described territory is incorporated in Stevens County Fire District No. 13: Parcel #2322000 of T37 R39 S05 and parcel #2324000, 2323455, 2323950, 2323500, 8000367, 2323600, 2324315, 2324310, 2324305, 2324321, 2324322, 2324100, 2324200 and 2324300 of T 37 R39 S08 and parcel #2325650, 2326150, 2326156, 2325800, 2326000 and 2326035 of T37 R39 S09 and parcel #2323001, 2323100 and 2323050 of T37 R39 S07 (EWM) **as per the attached documentation.**

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 31st day of May, 2016.



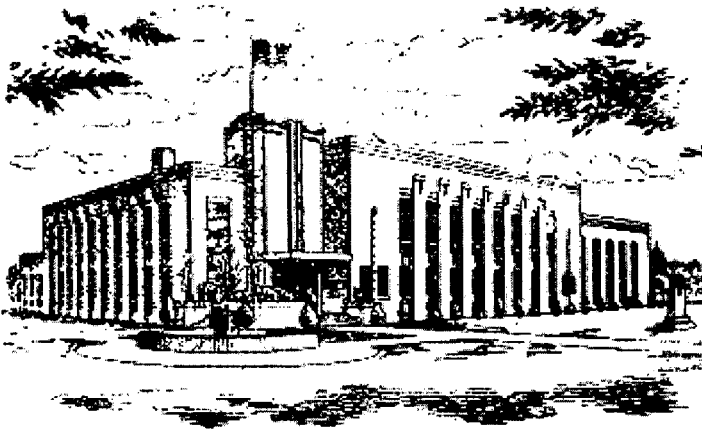

CERTIFICATE OF SIGNATURE SUFFICIENCY

Dear County Commissioners:

The Election Section of the Stevens County Auditor's Office has examined the Resolution 01-2016 signatures received from Stevens County Fire Protection District #13 on April 13, 2016 and find that 20 of the 22 signatures presented are from qualified registered electors in the defined annexation area. Two signatures were not registered voters in Stevens County. We also determined that there are 22 qualified registered electors in the requested annexation area. So 20 of the 22 registered voters approve the annexation for a approved percentage of 90.91%. This exceeds the minimum requirement of 15% and the 60% majority needed to avoid placing this annexation on the ballot.

On May 20, 2016, Stevens County Fire Protection District #13 presented Resolution 04-2016 correcting some legal description errors found in Resolution 01-2016. These changes did not affect the signature calculations or qualified registered electors described above.




WHEREAS, the registered voters who signed the petition to annex believe that it would be conducive to the public safety, welfare, and peace of mind to be included in the fire district; and,
