PERMITTING DESIGN DEVIATION
TO MINIMUM ALLOWABLE WIDTH
CATTLEGUARD FRANCHISE NO. C-01-2016

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 49-2015 regarding cattleguards and appurtenances; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 49-2015 specifies minimum allowable standards for construction of cattleguards and appurtenances; and

WHEREAS, The US Forest Service has applied for and been granted a franchise No. C-01-2016 for construction of a cattleguard on the Middle Fork Mill Creek Road in Stevens County; and

WHEREAS, The US Forest Service has requested that the Board of County Commissioners permit a lessor width cattleguard than that allowable by Resolution No. 49-2015; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners has determined that construction of a cattleguard meeting the width requirements of Resolution No. 49-2015 is not possible because of the narrow road width and significant physical obstacles.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that a one-time non-precedent setting design deviation is granted to the US Forest Service for the width of the cattleguard authorized under franchise No. C-01-2015; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cattleguard shall not be less than 16 feet in total width.


