RESOLUTION NO. 69-2016

ESTABLISHING A CITIZENS' STEERING
COMMITTEE FOR LAKE MANAGEMENT
DISTRICT 1-2016 AT DEER LAKE

WHEREAS, the Board finds a lake management district for control of Eurasian milfoil and any other state-listed aquatic and/or riparian noxious weeds has been established for Deer Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it advisable to establish a citizens' steering committee to provide advice and make recommendations to the county as to the management and administration of the lake management district and the control of the Eurasian milfoil and any other state-listed aquatic and/or riparian noxious weeds;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

1. There is hereby established a Deer Lake Management District Citizens' Steering Committee (DLMDCSC) with a maximum of nine members.
2. Any person wishing to serve as a member of the DLMDCSC shall submit a written letter of application to the Board of County Commissioners which must be received **no later than 4:30 p.m. Friday, December 9, 2016.** The letter shall identify the person applying, provide information as to why that person wishes to serve on the DLMDCSC and why their input would be useful or helpful to the County.
3. The Clerk is authorized and directed to advertise the formation of the DLMDCSC and the application process.
