IN THE MATTER of Resolution No. 78-2016 adopted by the Board of Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, dated November 29, 2016, declaring the public necessity and intention to establish the following road:

Beginning at a point where said road intersects Mountain Resort Rd. #29950 at its milepost .33, thence in a southeasterly direction for approximately 3,760 feet through the NW1/4, S1/2 of Section 6, Township 32 North, Range 42 East, W.M. and for 2,963 feet southwesterly rounding to the East at its end through the N1/2 of Section 7, Township 32, Range 42 East, W.M. for a total mileage of 1.27. Said road description also described on the Alpine Developments Group, LLC plans for Nelson Creek Road Improvements.

WHEREAS, heretofore the Board fixed and appointed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2016, at the hour of 11:30 a.m., in the Commissioners Office located at 230 East Birch Avenue in Colville, Washington, as the time and place for a public hearing; and


WHEREAS, the Board having considered all evidence relative thereto adjudge; that said proposed County Road is public necessity and practicable.




