

BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEVENS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

IN THE MATTER DECLARING COUNTY PROPERTY SURPLUS	RESOLUTION NO. <u>16-2017</u>  SETTING A HEARING DATE AND PUBLISHING NOTICE

WHEREAS, RCW Chapter 36.34 provides authority and a procedure for disposing of county property; AND

WHEREAS, the Board of Stevens County Commissioners desires to dispose of the surplus county property (approximately 700 tons of scrap metal located at the Stevens County landfill); AND

WHEREAS, RCW Chapter 36.34 provides that a hearing date must be set and notice published.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington that:

1. The Board desires to dispose of approximately 700 plus tons of scrap metal located at the Stevens County landfill.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.34.040, a hearing shall be held on **Tuesday, June 6, 2017 at 11:30 a.m.** in the Stevens County Commissioners' Office; 230 East Birch; Colville, Washington for the purpose of hearing evidence on the proposal to dispose of the above county property.
3. The Clerk of the Board is authorized and directed to publish a notice of the Board's intention to dispose of the above property and notice of hearing pursuant to the provisions of RCW Chapter 36.34.020 and 36.34.030.


