WHEREAS, it appearing to the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, that because of a written request from all adjacent landowners to vacate a portion of Thomas Road, the following portion of road has ceased to justify its existence as a County Road:

A portion of Thomas Road LMO # 30400, commencing at said roads intersection with Esvelt Road at milepost .46 thence northeasterly for approximately.57 mile to its intersection with address 3083 Thomas Rd; all within Sections 15 & 16, Township 33 N., Range 37 E.W.M.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Board that it is its intention to vacate and abandon the above described portion of road, said Vacation to be known as:

Vac #1 in Thomas Road (Portion of) No. 3450

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Road Engineer be, and hereby is, ordered to report upon said Vacation and Abandonment at a public hearing to be held in the Commissioners Hearing Room, 230 East Birch Ave, Colville, Washington on **August 22nd at 10:45 a.m.** This to be done in accordance with R.C.W. Chapter 36.87.


