IN THE MATTER of Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, declaring the intention to vacate and abandon the following described portion of County Road:

A 60 foot wide strip of property being Mill Street between Block 2 and Block 4 all west of Main Street in Section 13, Township 33 North, Range 39 East, W.M. Said strip of land more particularly described and shown on Map of Resurvey of Blocks 3 and 4 of Addy, Book A, Page 93.


This matter coming on regularly for hearing on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2017, at 10:30 a.m. it appearing that notice of said hearing has been given for the time and in the manner provided by law, it further appearing that the portion of road described herein is no longer necessary as a public road; that the vacation will be a benefit to Stevens County, and there being no reasonable evidence presented in opposition to the vacation and abandonment thereof, and the Board being fully advised in the premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, that the strip of non-built road described above is hereby vacated and abandoned as a County Road.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 22nd day of August, 2017.


