BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, that the Gold Creek Loop Road Slide Reconstruction Project be established as a project for reconstructing 0.20 miles of said road from M.P. 0.26 to M.P. 0.46; AND,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Gold Creek Loop Road Slide Reconstruction Project be designated as CRP-814; AND,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this project is hereby declared to be a public necessity and the County Road Engineer is hereby ordered and authorized to report and proceed thereon as by law provided in R.C.W. 36.75 and R.C.W. 36.80; AND,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an appropriation from the officially adopted road fund budget and based on the County Engineer's estimate is hereby made in the amounts and for the purposes shown:

Right of Way Acquisition	<u>\$ 0.00</u>
Construction	<u>\$ 585,000.00</u>
Total	<u>\$ 625,000.000</u>

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted annual road program in accordance with RCW 36.81.130 and that construction is to be accomplished by contract in accordance with RCW 36.77.020 et. seq.
