WHEREAS, the Board finds that the cleanup process requires loads of contaminated soil to be watered for safe transport to the Stevens County Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that disposition of said soil has been approved by the Northeast Tri County Health District as intermediate cover at the Stevens County Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that as a result of transporting procedures a higher than normal moisture content is possessed by the soils; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the water (up to 25 percent) contained within the soils is expected to evaporate as a result of normal landfill operations; and

WHEREAS, the soil will be of a beneficial use to the Stevens County Landfill.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the tipping fee at the Stevens County Landfill be reduced by 25 percent for this EPA project and shall constitute a one-time, project specific tipping fee reduction only.


