WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 36.80.010, the Board of County Commissioners is required to retain a registered and licensed professional civil engineer as County Road Engineer; AND

WHEREAS, when the position of Stevens County Road Engineer became vacant in 2016, Jason Hart was designated as Acting County Engineer for an interim period not to exceed six months and then Joseph L. Cunningham, PE was designated as the County Road Engineer for Stevens County; AND

WHEREAS, following a request for qualifications, qualified applicants were interviewed and Wayne Cornwall was selected and designated the part-time County Road Engineer for Stevens County by Resolution No. 17-2017, effective June 6, 2017; AND

WHEREAS, the Board advertised to fill the position of Public Works Director/County Engineer; applicants' qualifications were reviewed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Stevens County Board of County Commissioners that **Wayne Cornwall** is hereby appointed as Stevens County Public Works Director/County Engineer, effective April 1, 2018.


IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that **Wayne Cornwall** will be a county employee; therefore, his existing contract with the county is hereby repealed.
