Resolution No. 4 -2018  
ESTABLISHING NEW FEES FOR LAND  
DIVISIONS AND BUILDING PERMITS IN  
WRIA 55 AND WRIA 59

WHEREAS, the Board finds that Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 6091, which was signed in to law on Friday, January 19, 2018, authorizes and requires Stevens County to collect a \$500 fee with applications for building permits or the subdivision of land when the water supply is to be provided by a groundwater withdrawal exempt from permitting under RCW 90.44.050 and certain other conditions are satisfied.

WHEREAS, the State of Washington finds that the referenced fee serves a valid public purpose and is in the public's interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

1. The findings above are incorporated by this reference and made part of this Resolution.
2. The Land Services Department is authorized and instructed to collect a fee of \$500 with the specified applications when conditions established in Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 6091 are satisfied.
3. The Land Services Department is instructed to modify the site analysis application and reporting process as necessary to properly administer and collect the fees authorized herein.
