WHEREAS, it appearing to the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, that because of non-use and a written request signed by the adjacent landowner, the following has ceased to justify its existence as a County Road:

A 50 foot wide strip of property located in the OK Addition to Kettle Falls on the East side of Columbia Street, adjacent to lots 19 through 29 of Block 39, and Easterly of entire lot "Reserved for Residence in Section 26, Township 36 North, Range 37 East, W.M. Said property more particularly described and shown on Map of OK Addition to Kettle Falls, Book A Page 28.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Board that it is its intention to vacate and abandon the above described unbuilt property, said vacation to be known as:


VACATION #2 IN COLUMBIA STREET OF OK ADDITION TO KETTLE FALLS

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Road Engineer be, and hereby is, ordered to report upon said vacation and abandonment at a public hearing to be held in the Stevens County Commissioners' Office; 230 E. Birch Avenue; Colville, Washington on **Monday, August 27th, 2018 at 10:45 a.m.** This to be done in accordance with R.C.W. Chapter 36.87.
