IN THE MATTER of Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, declaring the intention to vacate and abandon the following described portion of County Easement:

A 50 foot wide strip of property located in the OK Addition to Kettle Falls on the East side of Columbia Street, adjacent to lots 19 through 29 of Block 39, and Easterly of entire lot "Reserved for Residence in Section 26, Township 36 North, Range 37 East, W.M. Said property more particularly described and shown on Map of OK Addition to Kettle Falls, Book A Page 28.

This matter coming on regularly for hearing on the 27th day of August, 2018, at 10:45 a.m. it appearing that notice of said hearing has been given for the time and in the manner provided by law, it further appearing that the portion of roads and alley described herein is no longer necessary as a public easement; that the vacation will be a benefit to Stevens County, and there being no reasonable evidence presented in opposition to the vacation and abandonment thereof, and the Board being fully advised in the premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, that the strip of non-built road described above is hereby vacated and abandoned as County Easements.


