ESTABLISHING A CITIZENS'  
STEERING COMMITTEE FOR THE  
LOON LAKE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT  
1-2018

WHEREAS, the Board finds a lake management district for control of Eurasian milfoil and other potential aquatic and/or riparian noxious weeds has been established for Loon Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it advisable to establish a citizens' steering committee to provide advice and make recommendations to the county as to the management and administration of the lake management district and the control of the Eurasian milfoil and other potential aquatic and/or riparian noxious weeds.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

1. There is hereby established a Loon Lake Management District Citizens' Steering Committee (LLMDCSC) to serve for the duration of Loon Lake LMD 1-2018 (2019 through 2023).
2. Any person wishing to serve as a member of the LLMDCSC shall submit a written letter of application to the Board of County Commissioners which **must be received no later than 4:30 p.m. Wednesday, November 28, 2018**. The letter shall identify the person applying and provide information as to why that person wishes to serve on the LLMDCSC and why their input would be useful or helpful to the County.
3. The Clerk is authorized and directed to advertise the formation of the LLMDCSC and the application process.




